

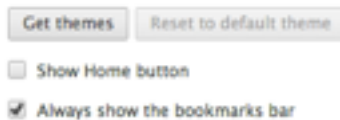
Cleaning Adware from Chrome

If Chrom suddenly starts defaulting to a different search engine or ads begin popping up on your screen, you are probably infected with malware or adware.

To remove the adware:

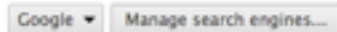
- Launch Chrome and open Chrome Preferences
- Scroll to bottom of page and click “Show advanced settings”
- Scroll to bottom of page and click “Reset browser settings”
- In the pop-up window, click “Reset”
- Scroll back up to the Search heading on the Preferences page
